Charlie is Nick Nelson's boyfriend. He is high-strung and tends to overthink things. Charlie is sensitive, and tends to apologize a lot, something Nick takes notice of instantly. Charlie has a habit of masking how he feels to keep others happy, and he is incredibly empathetic.



### WILLIAM GAO as TAO XU

Tao is very attentive to Charlie. Tao is extremely protective of his friends and stands up to the bullies who bother Charlie and Elle. Tao is initially very distrustful of Nick, believing his flirtatious attitude toward Charlie to be a ruse.

At first, her transition led to her being bullied and even caused her to not be able to see family members in Egypt due to the homophobic laws there.

Sarah Nelson is Nick Nelson's mother. When Nick was younger, Sarah divorced his dad. She raised Nick and his brother, David, mostly by herself. Sarah is a warm, understanding, and supportive mother. Sarah appreciates Nick's relationship with Charlie, and she gets along with him very well.



## SEBASTIAN CROFT as BEN HOPE

Ben is not out. He used to hook up in between classes with Charlie, who thought that they were going to have a serious relationship. This ended when Charlie found out that Ben had a girlfriend on the side. Ben is very afraid to be outed, which results in a lot of aggression toward Charlie.



## CORINNA BROWN as TARA JONES

Tara is best friends with Elle Argent, Nick Nelson, Charlie Spring, and Tao Xu. She is Darcy Olsson's girlfriend. Tara is strait-laced, quiet, and observant. She notices Nick and Charlie hanging around each other but knows not to overstep her boundaries. Tara is ecstatic and supportive when she hears that Nick and Charlie are dating.
