Jeff Lowe posed as an employee,

156

00:08:24 --> 00:08:28 and he was able to divert millions of dollars in donated goods

157

00:08:29 --> 00:08:32 and then sell them through his liquidation business

158

00:08:32 --> 00:08:34 to turn a profit for himself.

159

00:08:35 --> 00:08:38 [Exotic on recording] Fourteen-million dollars of donated stuff

160

00:08:38 --> 00:08:40 that he turned around and sold.

161 00:08:40 --> 00:08:42 It was an ungodly amount.

162

00:08:42 --> 00:08:45 The money did not go to the victims of domestic abuse.

163

00:08:45 --> 00:08:47 It went into Jeff Lowe's pocket.

164

00:08:47 --> 00:08:49 [Jeff] The feds were watching my bank account.

165

00:08:49 --> 00:08:51 They wanna charge me with five counts of wire fraud.

166

00:08:53 --> 00:08:58 That may not sound like a big crime, but it comes with a big penalty. 00:08:58 --> 00:09:02 It's a felony charge and it can lead to up to 20 years in prison.
